Dear Parent

Keeping this in mind, the School has decided to start physical schooling from the new Academic Session 2021-22. The new session for Grade 9 will begin from Tuesday, 6th April 2021.

Please be ensured that the Standard Operating Procedure for health, hygiene and safety as advised by the CBSE will be strictly followed.

Please note the following important points:-

1. Consent of the parents is must for child to come to school.
2. The initial School timings are from 9 am to 2 pm. The School timings may be increased subject to the conduciveness of the prevailing situation at that time.
3. Students are expected to report in proper school uniform.
4. Wearing of masks is mandatory.
5. Students to carry their own water bottles and lunch. Sharing of water bottles and lunch is strictly prohibited.
6. Canteen facility will not be available.
7. The school shall follow all safety protocols and measures as proposed by Ministry of Health like cleaning and disinfecting of all areas, seating arrangement as per the social distancing norms.
8. Self monitoring of health by students and parents is essential. The student should not come to school even in case of minor illness.
